Snow Removal: Our guidelines for snow removal are at least 3 inches of snow. Pinnacle will begin to plow the streets after the snowfall has stopped. They will then do the driveways and finally the sidewalks based on condition. They will not do a driveway that has a car parked on it. I'm also confident that our own snow warriors will be out helping their neighbors dig out so be sure to thank them.

Our full board meetings will now be held every other month. In the off months we will still hold a Community Open Issues session followed by an Executive session (not open to the Community).

In the near future we will be experimenting with reflective tape on our two gates to help with better visibility at night.



Parking in the street is not allowed. Park in driveways and garage and leave the overflow parking on Samari, Latherous and the Clubhouse for your guests.

<u>DOG WASTE</u> must be picked up at the time it happens and disposed of at your condo. We are still continuing to see dog waste not being picked up as it should. Please keep the neighborhood as clean as possible. No tethering of dogs at any time.

Speeding in the neighborhood above <u>14mph</u> is not allowed. Please be careful while driving in the neighborhood as many people are walking for exercise and walking their dogs.

Any proposed work that you want to do to the outside of your condo must be submitted via an Exterior Modification Form from our Property Manager. All forms for your use are located on the website.

Use of the clubhouse is in the fall-winter lower rate period. The price is now \$25.00 a day until Memorial Day. Please contact the PMC to schedule your event.

Remember to change the batteries in your SMOKE DETECTOR, and please clean your clothes dryer vent. Both should be done at least once a year!

RECOMMENDATION: Leaving our porch (garage) lights on at night since we do not have street lights to guide the way for those late-night walkers.
